COVID Cancellation Policy:

All covid restrictions have been lifted in Newfoundland as of March 14. This includes capacity limits, physical distancing, proof of vaccination requirements and masks. Of course, you may wear a mask if you wish. Vaccination requirements are suspended. A COVID-19 test result nor proof of vaccination is required to board a flight or train in Canada. If you are asking yourself; what if I purchase a registration and the event cannot move forward? Do I lose my money? The answer is **NO**. CCNA includes the following in our Cancellation Policy: "Refunds for cancellation will only be issued due to any provincial health regulations in Newfoundland and Labrador that would prohibit the convention from taking place".
